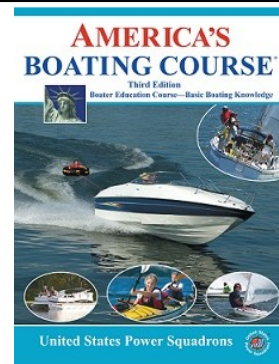


## In-person Boating Safety Classes with Supplemental On-the-water Training



Students are offered a choice of two at-home, read-ahead options to support learning boating safety fundamentals. **At-home preparation is critical for establishing a base of knowledge upon which the classroom experience builds.** The options are:

- **TWRA option** is a free downloadable 60-page textbook.
- **ABC3 option** costs \$35 for on-demand online instruction with a downloadable 270-page textbook, practice exam, and certificate; go to [www.americasboatingcourse.com](http://www.americasboatingcourse.com).

**All classes conclude with an in-person exam.** Passing (80% grade) earns a class completion certificate that is typically accepted by insurance carriers, who offer discounts for boat owners attending boating education. Passing also permits you to obtain a TWRA-issued wallet card.

*Any Tennessee resident born after January 1, 1989, and operating a boat with more than 8.5 hp must show the TWRA-issued wallet Boating Safety Education Certificate as proof of successful completion of the TWRA Boating Safety exam..*

**Class Venue:** Classes are at Grace Lutheran Church, 131 W Gettysburg Ave, Oak Ridge, TN 37830.

**Class Time:** All classes consist of **two 2-hour sessions** that are **between 7 and 9 PM**. Nearly all classes are on Tuesdays and Thursdays in the same week.
