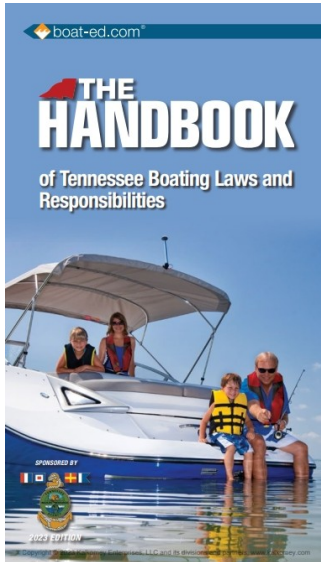


TWRA boating safety classes

Any Tennessee resident born after January 1, 1989, must show the TWRA-issued wallet Boating Safety Education Certificate as proof of successful completion of the TWRA Boating Safety exam. The certificate requires the student to purchase, for \$10.00, a Type 600 boating safety exam permit from any business (license agent) that sells hunting and fishing licenses.

Springtime On-the-Water Boating Safety Training – Tellico Lake

Experience what you learned in boating safety classes. This on-the-water training supplement is timed to follow boating safety classes scheduled in Tellico Village by the USCG Auxiliary. Unlike America's Boating Clubs, USCG Auxiliary Flotillas aren't permitted to do on-the-water training. This cooperative effort is meant to help students in a single session 4-hour class better comprehend all the knowledge they received.

The training agenda includes:

- Maneuvering, docking and undocking
- Aids to navigation and charts
- Rules of the Road demonstrations
- Anchoring and rafting to other boats
